# ANDICURI TO DRY-DOCK AT DINACOL IN CARTAGENA

During the month of April the Andicuri tug will be sent to DINACOL in Cartagena, Colombia. The boat will be out of service for a two (2) to three (3) week period as it will go into dry dock for maintenance work and minor repair. In preparation for the impending work Lloyd's Register Surveyor representatives will be arriving in Aruba the second week of April to conduct pre-dry docking measurements and inspections. They will assess the boat's general condition and prepare a detailed list of work to be done among others.

During its absence, Andicuri will temporarily be replaced by a Valero tug.



# THE NORTH AMERICAN ECA OUR BUSINESS OPPORTUNITY?

Many key stakeholders in the Caribbean cruise industry feel that a pan-Caribbean Emissions Control Area (ECA) would be economic suicide. The main reason, simple: if necessary the lines can and will move their ships elsewhere.

In general it would be safe to say that the sentiment among regional partners is that the US ECA will have a positive effect on non-English speaking Caribbean countries and strongly advice against introducing one on the entire Caribbean region.

Among other business opportunities mentioned as a result of the US ECA include, but are not limited to, the importation of low-Sulfur fuel for bunkering at local ports, attract more ships to call at ports in the region who provide "green" power (gas from sugar cane production), and increase home porting in the Southern Caribbean. \*Summary of interview held by Tony Peisley with regional stakeholders, including Aruba Port Director Alfonso Boekhoudt, on whether the North American Emissions Control Area is good or bad for the Caribbean and if the region eventually would get its own ECA anyway.

#### **CRUISE**


A total of **42** calls, **80,039** passengers, and **32,392** crew members were recorded by the port this month.
